That's why I strongly recommend having one's eyes and heart open to receive poems and stories any time they choose to come, and in any form they choose to take. They need us, and we need them.

The poems and stories gathered in this collection are called short shorts. The shortest one is just one line and the longest is not longer than a page. Some stories are very clear and straightforward just as some poems are very poetic. But there are other fascinating options, too: a bunch of loose sentences that somehow come together; a story that strikes you or makes sense after you left it and got busy with something else. And even if there's no sense, initially, you can make one.

There are a few ways to use this book. You can read them one by one as they appear, for they form a larger story. Or, you can choose the page at random. My suggestion is not to read too much at one go. Savour a story, let it develop, let it bloom and bring fruit. If you want to, try your hand at continuing or elaborating on a text that you find intriguing. Write your own poem or a story based on the one you've just read.

I'm forever grateful to all of you, my dear students of classes 8a and 8b, for writing and sharing these incredible texts with me over the whole school year during our short tests within what started as a modest innovation entitled "How to befriend irregular verbs". I cherish each text as I cherish each one of you.

I believe in collecting poems and stories, and letting them out into the world. They will find their way.

You will, too.
